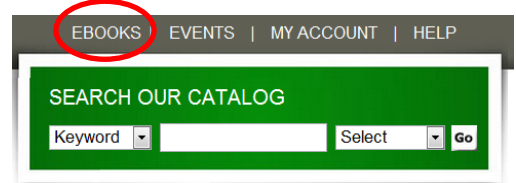




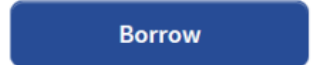
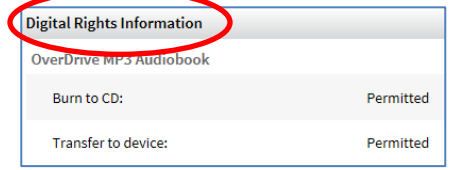
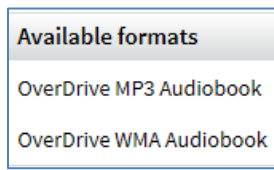
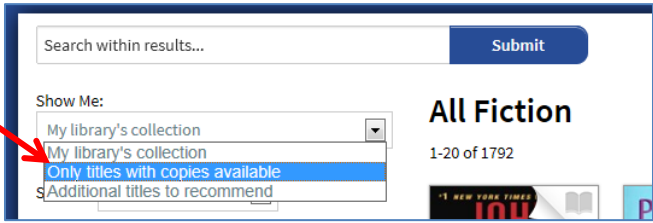
Downloading eAudiobooks to a Computer or MP3 Player (Overdrive)

Get an eAudioBook:

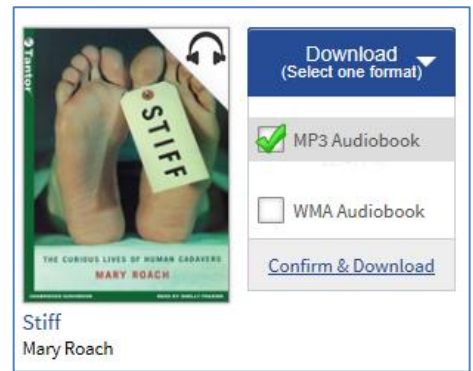
1. Go to www.mentorpl.org.
2. Click on the **EBOOKS** link in the grey line at the top of the screen.
3. Browse or search our collection for the title you want.
 - Search by book title or author by typing in the search bar.
 - Browse by category by clicking the appropriate category link in the grey bar.
 - You can narrow the search by choosing "Only titles with copies available" from the Show Me: box.



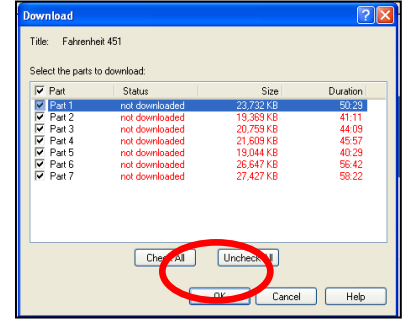
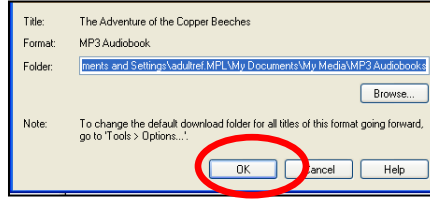
4. When you find an audiobook you're interested in, click on it.
 - If the audiobook is currently checked out to another patron, select "Place a Hold" to get on the waiting list. OverDrive (our eBook downloading service) will email you when the title becomes available.
 - Make sure the audiobook is available in a format you can use. Check the **Available formats** box to the right of the audiobook information. (MP3 format can be accessed by most devices. WMA format cannot be used on many Apple devices.)
 - Click on the **The Digital Rights Information** title box at the bottom of the page to discover what can be done with the audiobook. (Can you burn it to CD? Can you transfer it to an MP3 player?)



5. If the audiobook is available for check out, select **Borrow**.
6. Enter your library card number. (All 14 digits, no spaces.)
7. Select **Download**.
 - Click in the box in front of the appropriate format type.
8. Click **Confirm & Download**.



9. Overdrive Media Console should automatically open. (If you do not have Overdrive Media Console you can download it by clicking on the Get Software link to the right of your Account page. Follow the directions provided.)



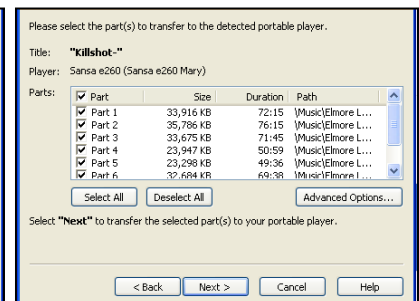
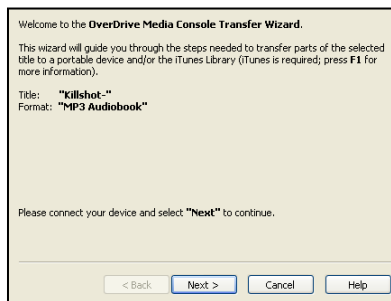
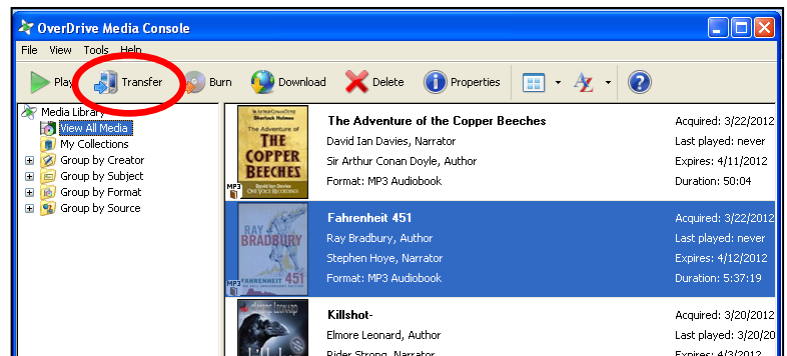
- Click **OK** to tell the computer where to save the file.
- Decide the number of parts you would like to download. A checkmark in the box indicates it will be downloaded. (Each part contains about an hour of audio.) Click **OK**.
- A progress bar (at the bottom of the overdrive window) will indicate how much of the item has been downloaded.



- The eAudiobook will appear in the Overdrive Media Console.
- Click on the book to select it.
- Click the **Play** button to begin listening to the book.

Transfer Library Books to an MP3 player:

- Connect your MP3 player to the computer using the USB cable. Make sure the MP3 is turned on and awake.
- Open **Overdrive Media Console**.
- Click on the book to select it.
- Click the **Transfer** button (at the top of the window.)
- A window will open to help with the transfer. Click **Next**.
 - Decide the number of parts you would like to download. A checkmark in the box indicates it will be transferred. (Each part contains about an hour of audio.)
 - Click **Next**.
- A progress bar will appear indicating how much of the item has been transferred.
- Click **Finish** when the transfer has been completed. The book will now be available on the portable device.



- You can have up to 5 items out at a time
- eBooks checkout for up to 2 weeks
- Borrowed eBooks return themselves.
