



**Tiddlywinks! - Let's Get Silly!**

**Silly Little Goose by Nancy Tafuri.** A goose tries out a few odd places to make her nest before finally settling on an old straw hat.


**Time for a rhyme**

My foot waves hello!



*(continue rhyme with the following actions)*

### Opening rhyme:

#### ***Open, Shut Them***

Open, shut them. Open, shut them. (open and shut hands)

Give a little clap, clap, clap. (clap three times)

### Closing rhymes:

#### ***The Bellybutton Game***

### ***Father, Mother and Uncle John***

Father, Mother and Uncle John, (bounce baby on knee)

But Uncle John went on and on and on. (bounce baby on knee)

### ***Tick, Tock***

Tick, tock, tick, tock, I'm a little cuckoo clock. (rock baby side to side)

Tick, tock, tick, tock, I'm a little cuckoo clock.

Tick, tock, tick, tock, now I'm striking two o'clock. Cuckoo! Cuckoo! (lift baby two times)

Tick, tock, tick, tock, I'm a little cuckoo clock.

Tick, tock, tick, tock, now I'm striking three o'clock. Cuckoo! Cuckoo! Cuckoo! (lift baby three times)
