### Getting Started

Save the image you would like to print to a flash drive or attach it to an email to yourself so that you may access it on a computer in the Makerspace.

- **File format:** .JPEG or .PDF work best, but other formats may be supported
- **Dimensions:** Images must have at least one side that does not exceed 36 inches
- You'll get the best results for files with:
  - High resolution (up to 2400 x 1200 dpi)
  - Dimensions that match the final size of your poster
- Optional: Lamination is available (up to 24" wide) for a small additional cost
- Note: All print jobs must be approved by Library staff and cannot violate copyrights. Images that are commercially available will not be accepted for print at The HUB.

### Want to Design Your Own Poster?

You can find many resources online that allow you design your own posters without any previous graphic design experience! Most have customizable templates that are free to use, so you create stunning personalized graphics with minimal effort. When finished, just download your design and bring it to The HUB!
